ARTIST RESIDENCY IN BERLIN

The ART CLAIMS IMPULSE residency program consists of a four (4) week residency in which artists are encouraged to develop and complete one or more works of art, which will be exhibited in the gallery space for a period of 2 weeks, and will be potentially promoted thereafter.

Eligible for application are artists working with video and multimedia installations, as well as performance artists. The application should consist of a DVD of video, performance or installation work, as well as a proposal of the project(s) to be researched, developed, and/or produced during the time of the residency. Ideally, artists should provide a list of equipment required for exhibiting the produced pieces with the application.

All residents will be allocated a private room to be used for working and accommodation and will have access to up to three different 15m² - 20m² working spaces to research, record, and produce new work, or follow up on already initiated projects. Spaces are equipped with video viewing and recording facilities and with facilities for the building of multimedia installations. Artists are entitled to use the equipment owned by the gallery - i.e. beamers, recording camera, photo camera, etc. – but are also encouraged to use their own (i.e. laptop, camera). Depending on the requirements, ART CLAIMS IMPULSE can also provide contact to an acting school (if actors are required for performances) and contact to a sound studio (for the recording and editing of sound). The residency space is equipped with a fully fitted kitchen, sanitary facilities, and wireless internet. There will be no more than two resident artists working in the residency space at one time.

Resident artists will get the chance to interact with other international artists and a public interested in video and performance art that attend the video and performance art screening events organised at the gallery.

A fee of 692,20 € is charged for the residency (Short Residency Fee: 364,75 €). Artists are given the opportunity to spend the residency time in Berlin with their partner. The surcharge for the partner living in the designated private space would total 100.-€ for the four weeks.

ART CLAIMS IMPULSE – is a gallery specialised in video, multimedia, and performance art. The program consists of exhibitions and regular weekly screenings of international young and established video and performance art. It is located in Kreuzberg, a young and vibrant international area of Berlin.
